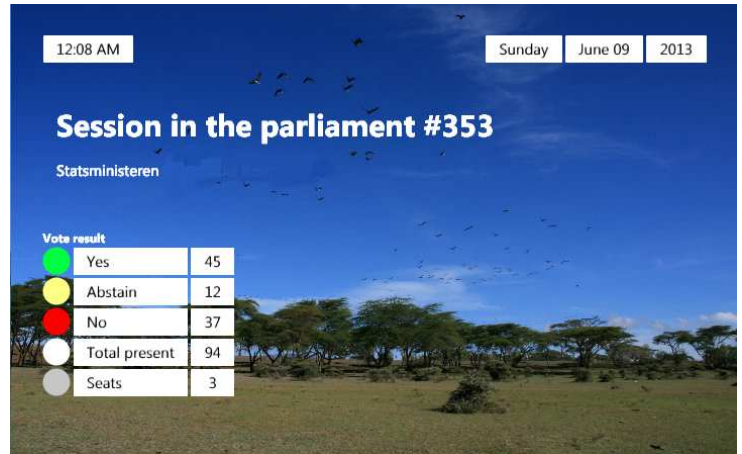




SW 6090 CDA Conference Display Application

Description

The CDA application is used inside and outside city halls, parliaments or other applications where a large number of people shall be kept informed about voting results, agenda or other relevant information.

The SW 6090 CDA Conference Display Application is an application in SW 6000 Conference Management Software used for presentation of screens with dynamic conference information content e.g.:

- Microphone status
 - Speakers list
 - Request list
 - Speech Time information
- Mimic (geographic) information
- Voting results
- Logged in information
- Agenda
- Messages before and after the conference

One or more CDA's can be installed on one or more PC's and the video output from the PC is used for displaying on various display devices like:

- Large screen projectors
- VGA/DVI monitors
- LED or plasma displays

Each of the CDA's In a system can be configured individually.

Screen content can be changed manually by a technician or chairman using the CUA Conference User Application or automatically controlled by conference events like starting or stopping a voting session.

The use of CDA is licensed as part of the SW 6000 Software License. The CDA can be Installed at as many PC's as needed, but only the licensed number can run simultaneously

Features

The SW 6090 CDA Conference Display Application has the following main features:

- Up to 16 CDA applications in one system
- Event controlled or manually controlled changing of screen content
- Built in Skin editor for changing appearance of screen content
 - Background color
 - Insertion of image
 - Alignment, position and opacity of image
 - Font types and colors
 - Lists appearances
- Scalability
 - Full screen or custom position of content
 - In full screen the content scales automatically to all screen resolutions
- Global font size changeable. When using large fonts less important information is removed automatically
- Format and information in screen contents configurable
- Option for making customized screens (advanced user)
- Available screen depends on SW 6000 Software License
